- Open to all players aged 18 years and above.
- Minimum 9 Picklers, Maximum 12 Picklers (Team Manager included)
- Each Pickler is allowed to play in Two (2) Categories ONLY
- Open to Twenty-Four (24) Teams – Eight (8) Groups of Three (3) Teams Round Robin with Top Two (2) to the Last 16 Teams (Win – 3, Lost – 0 Points)
- All Group, Round of 16, Quarterfinals & 3rd & 4th Play-Off Matches will be based on Classic 0-0-2 Game to 11 Points. End Change after Scoring 6. No Deuce. First to reach 11 wins.
- Semi-Finals & Final Match will be Classic 0-0-2 Game to 11 Points. End Change after Scoring 6. No Deuce. Best of Three (3) Sets
- 10 minutes Walkover will be strictly observed after Official Announcement of commencement of each match
- The format of competition is subject to adjustment according to the number of entries endorsed by the Organizer.

- Team Event is scheduled to start tentatively at 1900hrs, Friday, 9th October 2026.
- To ensure observance of gentlemanly conduct during the tie, "out ball or line call" will be based on Receiver's Call.

7.2 MIXED NOVICE 2.0 BELOW DOUBLES (Group & Knock - Out System)

- Open to all players aged 18 years and above.
- Both players must have a DUPR rating of 2.0 or below as of 31st July 2026.
- Limited to Twenty-Four (24) Double Pairs ONLY per Category on first-come-first-serve basis – Eight (8) Groups of Three (3) Pairs Round Robin with Top Two (2) to the Round of 16.
- A minimum of Eight (8) Doubles Pairs is required for each category. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel any category that receives fewer than Eight (8) registered pairs.
- All Group, Round of 16, & Quarterfinals will be based on on Classic 0-0-2 Game to 11 points. End Change after Scoring 6. No Deuce. First to reach 11 wins.
- Semi-Finals and Final Matches will be based on Classic 0-0-2 11pts. End Change after Scoring 8. No Deuce. Best of Three (3) Sets
- 10 minutes Walkover will be strictly observed after Official Announcement of commencement of each match
- The Mixed Novice 2.0 Below Double Event tentatively starts at 0800hrs, Friday, 9th October 2026.
- To ensure observance of gentlemanly conduct during the tie, "out ball or line call" will be based on Receiver's Call.

7.3 MEN'S, WOMEN'S AND MIXED INTERMEDIATE 3.5 BELOW DOUBLES (Group & Knock - Out System)

- Open to all players aged 18 years and above.
- Both players must have a DUPR rating of 3.50 or below as of 31st July 2026.
- Limited to Twenty-Four (24) Double Pairs ONLY per Category on first-come-first-serve basis – Eight (8) Groups of Three (3) Pairs Round Robin with Top Two (2) to the Round of 16.
- A minimum of Eight (8) Doubles Pairs is required for each category. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel any category that receives fewer than Eight (8) registered pairs.

- All Group, Round of 16, & Quarterfinals will be based on on Classic 0-0-2 Game to 11 points. End Change after Scoring 6. No Deuce. First to reach 11 wins.
- Semi-Finals and Final Matches will be based on Classic 0-0-2 11pts. End Change after Scoring 8. No Deuce. Best of Three (3) Sets
- 10 minutes Walkover will be strictly observed after Official Announcement of commencement of each match.
- The Mixed Intermediate 23.5 Below Double Event tentatively starts at 1500hrs, Friday, 9th October 2026.
- The Men's and Women's Intermediate 23.5 Below Double Event tentatively start at 1700hrs, Thursday, 8th October 2026.
- To ensure observance of gentlemanly conduct during the tie, "out ball or line call" will be based on Receiver's Call.

7.4 MEN'S AND WOMEN'S OPEN DOUBLES (Group & Knock - Out System)

- Open to all players aged 18 years and above. No DUPR rating restriction.
- Limited to Twenty-Four (24) Double Pairs ONLY per Category on first-come-first-serve basis - Eight (8) Groups of Three (3) Pairs Round Robin with Top Two (2) to the Round of 16.
- A minimum of Twelve (12) Pairs is required for each category. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel any category that receives fewer than Eight (8) registered pairs.
- All Group, Round of 16, & Quarterfinals will be based on on Classic 0-0-2 Game to 11 points. End Change after Scoring 6. No Deuce. First to reach 11 wins.
- Semi-Finals and Final Matches will be based on Classic 0-0-2 11pts. End Change after Scoring 8. No Deuce. Best of Three (3) Sets
- 10 minutes Walkover will be strictly observed after Official Announcement of commencement of each match
- The Men's Open Doubles and Women Double Open Event tentatively start at 1300hrs, Thursday, 8th October 2026.
- To ensure observance of gentlemanly conduct during the tie, "out ball or line call" will be based on Receiver's Call.

14. DISPUTES / COMPLAINTS / RESOLUTIONS

In the interest of the smooth running of the competition, ONLY the Team Manager are allowed to file any complaint(s) or dispute(s) to the Tournament Director or the Tournament Technical Director to be tabled to the Complaints Committee for Resolution.

A Non-Refundable Deposit of Ringgit Malaysia Five Hundred (RM500.00) is required before any complaint is heard/entertained by the organizer/appeals committee.

15. TEAM MANAGER'S MEETING

- 1900hrs on Thursday, 8th October 2026 at PIKABOL. Only Team Managers are invited.

16. RULES & REGULATIONS

- Final changes to the Team Event Registration can be made during the Team Manager's Meeting.
- No Refund for cancellation and No Changes after the Team and Individual Doubles Event draw has been made. The Organizer has the right to cancel or postpone the Tournament under specified conditions; entry fees shall be refunded accordingly.
- The rules & regulations for this tournament shall be based on the International Federation of Pickleball (IFP) Rules 2026 and Malaysian Pickleball Association (MPA) Bye Laws.

18. NOTICE OF EVENT POSTPONEMENT & CANCELLATION

In the event that the tournament is suddenly postponed and declared force majeure at short notice by the government due to unforeseen circumstances related to natural disasters, riots, outbreak of diseases, fire or any event deemed by government authority as a risk to public interest and safety, the organizer will observe the instruction to postpone or cancel the event without prejudice to any legal action that the participants may wish to take against the organizer e.g. claim for damage, loss, distress etc.... Under such circumstances the participants agree that they will not hold the organizer accountable for any form of loss caused to picklers registered for the event.

19. ALCOHOL / DRUGS / TOBACCO

Picklers registered to compete in this tournament are strictly prohibited from consuming alcohol, indulging in substance abuse, or smoking while participating. Any pickler found to have breached this requirement is deemed to have broken the universal tournament ethos and can endanger the smooth running of the event, mar the reputation of the hosts, and endanger the safety of other picklers and the public at large. For such breach of sports ethics, the organizer reserves the right to eject the affected pickler and prohibit the offender from further participation in the tournament. The team he/she represents may be subject to further action as deemed fit by the organizer.

While no alcohol and smoking restrictions apply to general spectators who are not participants in the tournament, substance abuse is strictly prohibited.
